2009 has been a great year for Selene service and commissioning work. We currently have five Selene trawlers in the water or on the hard.

Cadence, a 59 footer, came here for commissioning. We sent a crew down to Savannah in mid February to pick her up after she was unloaded from the transport ship. Initial work was completed by the end of April and her owners decided to remain for long term dockage and hurricane protection.



We are happy to have Luc Girouard back with his 53 foot ***Innu***. After cruising this winter he decided to make a few stainless steel upgrades to his deck, which we will fabricate, and other various improvements.
